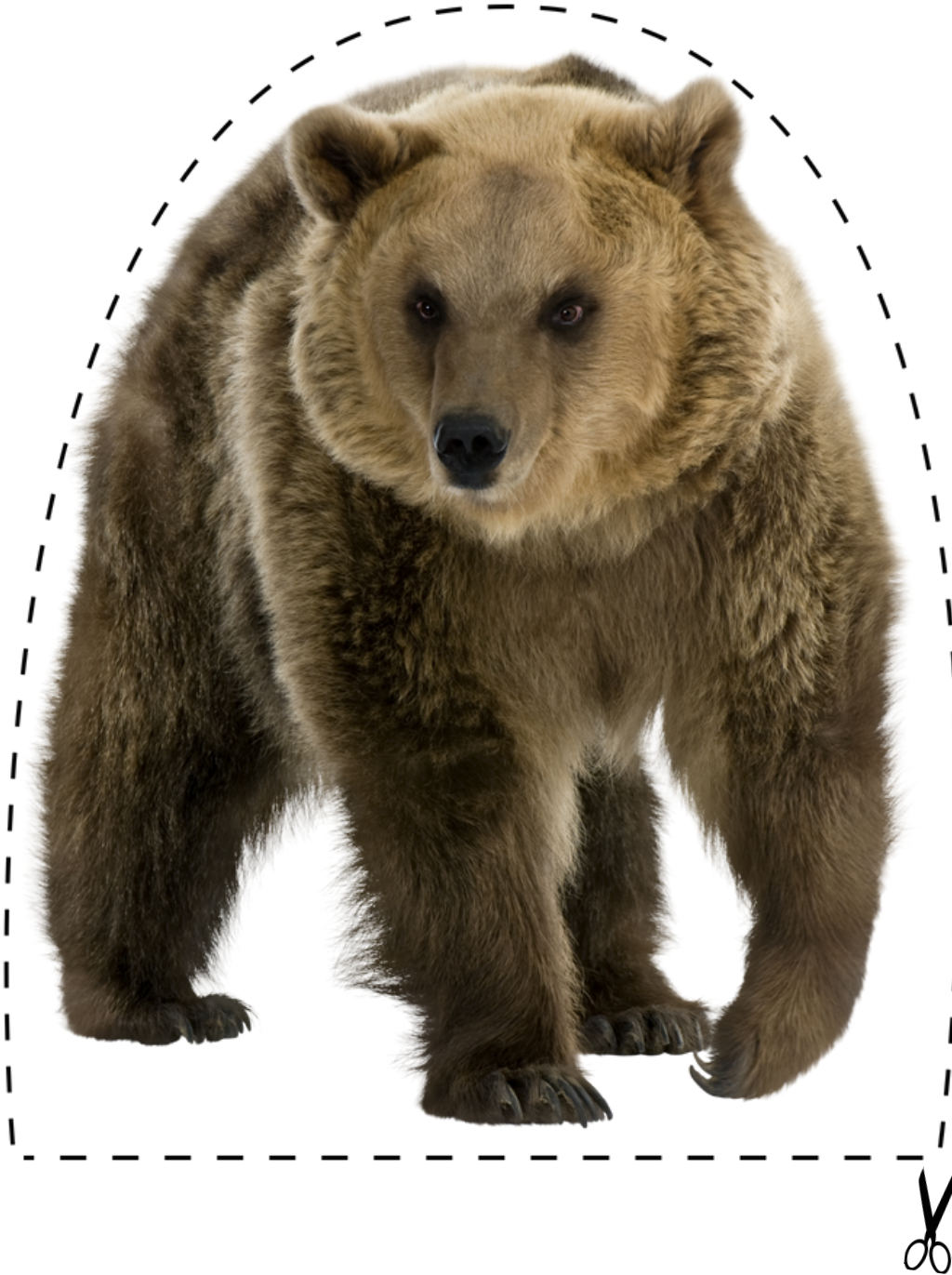

Attach a popsicle stick and use as a prop when "bear hunting".



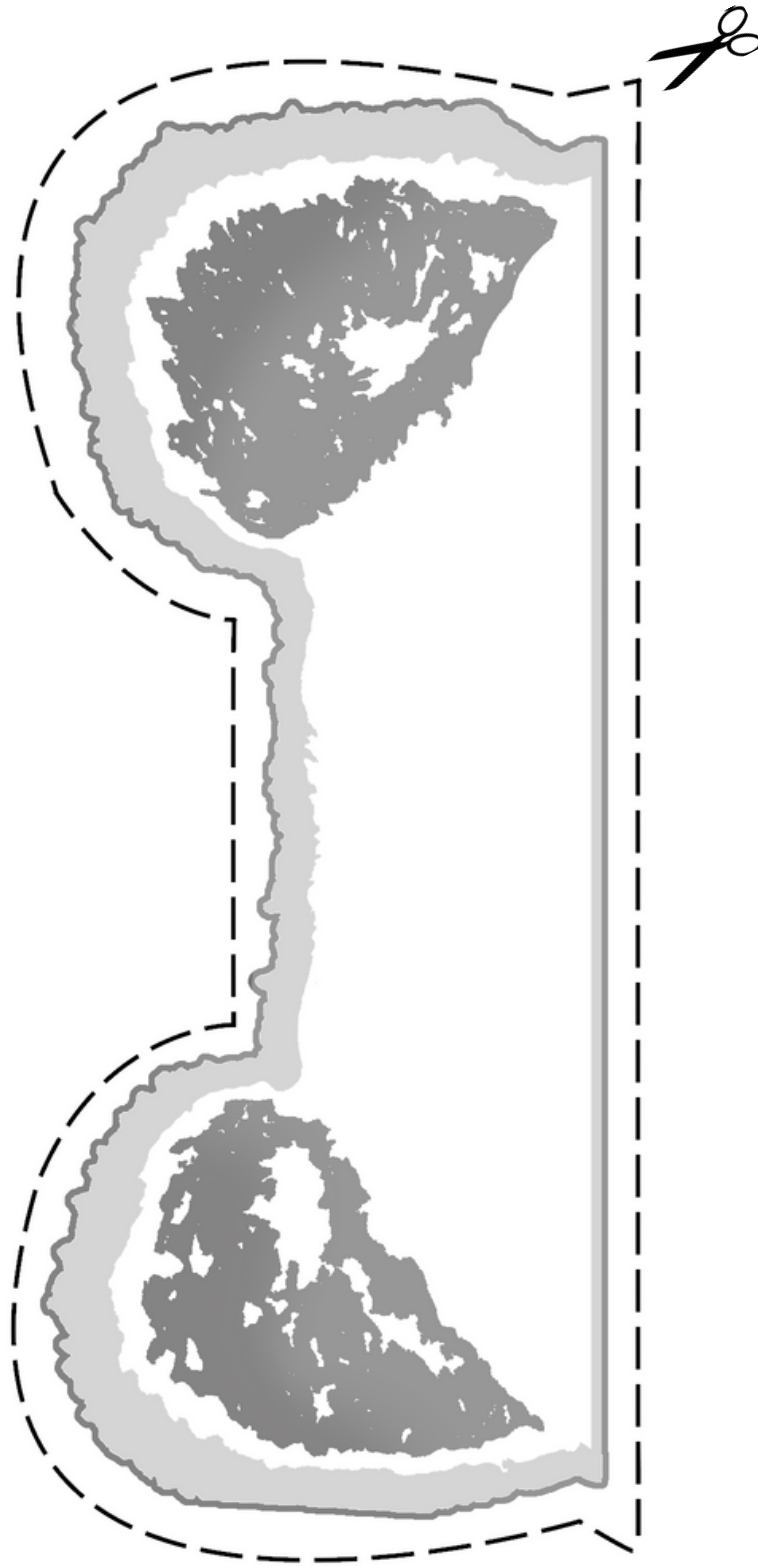
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We're Going on a Bear Hunt
